Malaysia

Malaysia has a unique mix of cultures, with 3,000 kilometers of coastline, the largest rainforest in the world, and the tallest mountain in Southeast Asia; it's easy to say Malaysia is full of contrasts.

Malaysia is located in Southeast Asia and near the equator. They are two distinct parts, Peninsular Malaysia to the west and East Malaysia to the east.

Malaysia was united in 1963 after independence from the British. Peninsular Malaysia is located south of Thailand, and north of Singapore, while east of the island in Indonesia, Sumatra. East Malaysia is located on the large island of Borneo and borders Indonesia and Brunei, and the Philippines to the north.

In Malaysia, floods can often occur and are particularly severe, especially in the northeastern part of Peninsular Malaysia.

The most famous landmark of Malaysia is Mount Kinabalu high 4095 meters asl is the highest mountain in Malaysia and is the 20th highest in the world.

Due to its biological diversity, the mountain has become a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The climb to the top is not easy, but the experience of doing it will give you immense joy.

1° Day: Kuala Lumpur

2° Day: Kuala Lumpur

After breakfast you will proceed to visit the city by visiting the following attractions:



The Kuala Lumpur Tower: is a communications tower located in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Its construction was completed on March 1, 1995. It features an antenna that increases its height to 421 meters (1,381 feet) and is the seventh tallest freestanding tower in the world. The pedestal is 335 meters (1,099 feet). The rest of the tower below has a stairwell and an elevator to reach the upper area, which also contains a revolving restaurant, giving diners a panoramic view of the city. The competitions are held every year, where participants run up the stairs to the top. The tower also serves as an Islamic falak observatory to observe the crescent moon which marks the beginning of the Muslim month of Ramadhan, Syawal and Zulhijjah, for celebrate the fasting month of Ramadhan, Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Aidiladha. The tower is the tallest observatory in Kuala Lumpur open to the public.

Aquaria KLCC: Ranked to be one of the largest aquariums in Southeast Asia. Home to over 150 species of marine life, its top attractions include scary tiger sharks, deadly sea snakes, blue rays, bright coral fish, seahorses, and more. It's a well-stocked aquarium that just begged to be explored, and after a few hours here you will have seen over 5,000 freshwater and marine creatures, including huge arapaimas, giant groupers, pike fish, and more. Some people write it off as a tourist trap, but they are getting badly lost - beyond the large tanks, with gallons of water,



filled with necklaces of algae, coral and mysterious and sometimes threatening sea creatures, it is a major tourist attraction. Of the country's attractions with real depth and complexity.

Kuala Lumpur Butterfly Park: is a large public butterfly zoo in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. It is a popular tourist attraction in the country. It is located adjacent to the Lake Gardens and Kuala Lumpur Bird Park. The butterfly park is home to many local species in the country. Over 80,000 square feet of landscaped garden with over 5,000 butterflies, plants, exotic plants, butterfly plants and ferns, is one of the largest houses in the world. The park also hosts an "exhibition area with information on butterflies and their insects. There is an "amazing collection of giant beetles, beautifully camouflaged insects in vivariums and their crawling disturbing.



Kuala Lumpur Bird Park It is a very popular gated attraction in the country that receives an annual average of 200,000 visitors. The Bird Park is home to over 3000 birds representing more than 200 species in an enclosed aviary. About 90% are local birds and 10% are imported from countries like Australia, China, Holland, Indonesia, New Guinea, Tanzania and Thailand. The bird park is part of the 60 hectares of Lake Gardens, which were established in 1888. In addition to the 20.9 acre (8.5 hectares) bird park, created in 1991, the gardens include an artificial lake, the National Monument, Deer Park, orchid and Hibiscus gardens and the former seat of the parliament of Malaysia. It is one of the largest indoor bird parks in the world. The park has been located on a hill in Bukit Aman.



Return and free time

3^o Day: Genting

After breakfast and check in you will go to Genting to visit the Temple of Batu Caves. The Temple can be reached with the 2-way cable car. The Temple is on the Bukit Aman hill.

The temple in Batu caves: The Batu cave temple is one of the most famous cave temples in Malaysia, and certainly one of the main attractions of Kuala Lumpur. This is a Hindu temple and according to some versions it is the largest of all Hindu temples outside India, but in reality it is not. But it is one of the most popular: there are always many pilgrims from all over the world and tourists. Almost all tourists who visit the capital try to see it. The temple is located in the largest of Batu's many caves, called "light." According to various estimates there are about 30 caves. Interesting of all caves with temples. The "paraphernalia of the temple begins at the foot of the mountain on the ground in front of the main staircase. Here you can see some simple temple buildings and statues. The main statue is a "huge 43-meter statue of Lord Murugan, recognizable images in many Malaysian tourism products.

4^o Day: Kuala Lumpur

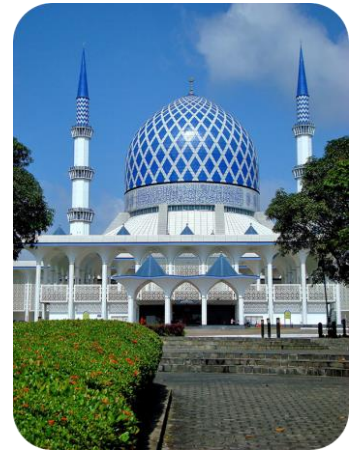
After breakfast and check out you will return to Kuala Lumpur, and you will be accompanied to the hotel - check in. free time

5° Day: Shah Alam City

After breakfast, you will proceed to Shah Alam City for the city tour.



Shah Alam is the capital of the state of Selangor and located within the Petaling district and in a small part of the neighboring Klang district. Shah Alam replaced Kuala Lumpur as the capital of the state of Selangor in 1978 due to the incorporation of Kuala Lumpur into a federal territory in 1974. Shah Alam was the first planned city in Malaysia after independence from Britain in 1957. Malaysia grew rapidly after its independence in 1957 under its second Prime Minister of Malaysia, Allahyarham Tun Abdul Razak Hussein. Shah Alam was once known as Sungai Renggam and was known for its oil palm and rubber properties. Later, the same area was identified as Batu Tiga before Malaysia's independence, and has been the center of trade for centuries of rubber and palm oil. The Sungai Renggam plantation was destined for the development of a township by the government of Selangor in 1963, and under the recommendations of Vlad Antlic, a United Nations town planning consultant, chose the current site strategically located between Kuala Lumpur and Port Klang. Its current name was chosen by the then Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, by his late father Sultan Alam Shah. Many other monuments, buildings and even a street are named after the late Sultan. Shah Alam was opened in 1963 with the aim of transforming it into the new administrative center of Selangor, replacing Kuala Lumpur, which became federal territory on February 1, 1974. With the consent of the Sultan, Shah Alam was proclaimed the capital of Selangor on December 7, 1978 with an area of 41.68 km² and administered by a city council. Shah Alam had encountered several processes to extend his areas and the latest was on January 1, 1997. Through the 1190 Gazette Plan, Shah Alam was extended to 293 km². Shah Alam obtained city status on October 10, 2000 with Dat "Haji Abu Sujak Haji Mahmud as first mayor. He recently served as deputy Menteri Besar, or Prime Minister of Selangor. Abu Sujak declared the vision to make Shah Alam a modern city with a unique "identity of Bandaraya Melayu (" Malay city ")", where the achievements of the Malay race in all areas are illustrated. In keeping with this identity, Shah Alam was declared the first city in the world without entertainment spots to avoid any vice activity.

While the name **Sunway Lagoon** doesn't really evoke any excitement, going there definitely will. Surprisingly, the destination is represented by 6 theme parks, in a single space offering over 90 attractions spread over a huge 88 acres. Sunway Lagoon features 6 zones, such as Water Park, Amusement Park, Wildlife Park, Extreme Park, Scream Park and Nickelodeon Lost Lagoon. Water Park: The Waters of Africa has 2 play areas for children, Kalahari Kids and Little Zimbabwe. Other water rides include Camern Climb, African Python, Cng Challenge, Vuvuzela, and

5D. The Surf Beach has Flwriider, Surf Beach, Mushrm / Umbrella, Water Disc, Surf Deck, Harbr Deck, Islands, Prmenade and Vlcan.

Scream Park: The Scream Park designed strictly fr ages 7 and lder, ffers 4 interactive "scare" experiences using audi, visual effects and live actrs. The 4 scary attractins are Pntianak Theater f Fear, Hrrrd Studis, Zmbie Apcalype and The Ghstbusters Adventure Live!.



Amusement Park: The park is split int 2 sides, Wild Wild West with 4 rides and Wrld f Adventure with 9 rides / attractins. Rides at Wild Wild West include Clrad Splash, Grand Canyn River Rapids, Vultures, and Butch Cassidy Trail. The Wrld f Adventure includes Pirate's Revenge, Tmahawk, Lst City f Gld Scream Caster, Apache Pts, Wagn Wheel, Carusel, Captain Kid's Candyland, Captain Kid's Playland and Malaysia's lngest suspensin bridge.

Wildlife Park: The Wildlife Park is an interactive and educatinal z featuring extic, small and friendly animals frm a range f birds, reptiles and mammals. The Wildlife Park is hme t ver 140 species, including the pygmy marmset and white lins amng the latest additins..



Nickelden Lst Lagn: With 14 new attractins fr all ages. Attractins include SpngeBb Splash Adventure, Primeval, Jungle Fury and Mnsn 360. The park als ffers green slime at a designated "time during the" Great Slime Deluge. "Visitrs can meet Nickelden characters: SpngeBb SquarePants, Patrick Star , Dra the Explrer, Bts and Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles.
