



### Bangkok Insolita Riverside con Mercati 5 days / 4 nights (min 2 pax)

#### Itinerario:

##### Day 1:

Arrival at Bangkok International Airport and transfer to the hotel. Free afternoon to relax after the long intercontinental flight. Free dinner. First overnight stay in **Bangkok**.

##### Day 2:

#### Breakfast and lunch included.

The first stop of the day will be the colorful **Maekhlong market**, crossed by the tracks of a secondary railway line. Here we will witness the spectacular passage of the small train, which slowly plunges into this active and teeming market, while the agile sellers move the goods just enough to be able to pass the convoy, and then resume shortly after all the activities as if nothing. is! Not far from here we find the **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**. On board a typical motor launch we will proceed along the exotic rural canals until we reach the well-known and picturesque market. Along the river, the nice wooden boats form an intricate bustle, where the vendors manage to extricate themselves easily to offer passers-by the products of the local cuisine and crafts. Time at your disposal to visit the bustling market and departure to immerse yourself again in the more traditional Thai rural countryside. Lunch in a local restaurant. This will be followed by a visit to **the coconut and salt farm** where we will learn how coconut is exploited to its full potential to produce sugar with the extracted sap, see how coconut oil is obtained which will then be used in cooking and cosmetics. You will see how to create beautiful handicrafts with coconut wood, tools, lamps, ornaments and much more. Return to Bangkok .



##### Day 3:

#### Breakfast and lunch included.

After breakfast at the hotel, meeting with the Italian speaking guide. The first stop of the day will be the famous **Wat Pho**, the "Temple of the Reclining Buddha", with its huge statue of the reclining Buddha, 15 meters high and 46 meters long. Wat Pho is the oldest Buddhist monastery in the city and also houses the oldest Thai massage school. Then by public boat we will reach Wat Arun, or "Temple of Dawn", a true symbol of the city and once the royal residence of King Taksin. It is located on the opposite bank of the Chao Praya River from Wat Pho and modern Bangkok. A short distance away, we will reach the characteristic district of Kudicheen (Kudi Chin), one of the first settlements in Bangkok after the destruction of Ayutthaya, which still preserves its identity and architecture intact. The picturesque wooden houses are protected by the splendid bell tower of the church of Santa Cruz, built by the Portuguese around 1770 and then renovated in a neo-Renaissance style by two Italian architects in the early 1900s. canals that



form the outskirts of the capital, along a path full of atmosphere until you reach the small village and get to know the local community, where time seems to have stopped. We will visit the ancient Thanusingha Bakery House which still bakes the delicious Portuguese sweets made with eggs and sugar, the small Baan Kudi Chin museum and the exotic, small Taoist temple of Kuan An Keng Shrine, immersed in a kaleidoscope of cultures perfectly in tune with each



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other. End of the visits and lunch in a local restaurant on the banks of the Chao Praya River. In the afternoon, the last and most important stop of the day: the majestic and amazing Royal Grand Palace with Wat Phra Kaew, the "Temple of the Emerald Buddha". The Royal Palace also includes the Chakri Palace (which can only be visited from the outside), the Dusit Palace and the Montien Palace, the latter which can only be visited inside in certain periods. End of visits around 4:30 pm and return to the hotel  
Free dinner. Third night in Bangkok.

### Day 4: Bangkok – Ayuttaya ( The ancient capital of Siam)

After Breakfast you will leave for the visit of the ancient city of Ayutthaya, formally called Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, where we will admire the most important temples of the city, which was the capital of Thailand for 417 years and was declared a World Cultural Heritage by UNESCO in 1981. .



The Cambodian-style pagodas of the immense Wat Chai Wattanaram, scenically set on the banks of the Chao Praya river, in a mystical and highly suggestive context; the famous



Wat Monkhon Bophit with its imposing and much revered statue of the Buddha in a sitting position. Bang Pa-In Royal Palace, also known as Summer Palace, is a complex of buildings once used by the Siamese rulers of the Kingdom of Ayutthaya, Wat Yai Chai Mongkol, built in 1592 by King Naresuan the Great to celebrate his victory over Burmese, Wat Mongkhon Bophit with its large bronze (gilded) Buddha image, called Phra Mongkhon Bophit, which is almost 17 meters high, Wat Phrasri Sanphet, which was the holiest temple and royal chapel of the ancient capital Ayutthaya until to which the Burmese razed it to the ground in 1767m, Wat Loka Suthawa, where there is the largest reclining Buddha image in Ayuttaya

During the visit we will have lunch in a local restaurant  
Return to Bangkok and free dinner

### Day 5:

After breakfast, free time until transfer to the airport or to any subsequent destinations. The room should be vacated not after noon.
